

Savannah's poverty, number of homeless, and crime rates are all some of nations worst.

58% of the people of Chatham County are religious but don't hold membership in a local church.



WHY ANOTHER CHURCH? 75% of Americans identify with a religion, but only 50% claim membership of a church.

* We've seen people rejected by the church because they didn't wear the right clothes.

* We've seen people rejected because they didn't act like everyone else.

We've seen the church operate like a country club for special members, instead of being a community unified around a mission and cause.

* We've seen people come in hurt and broken, and leave rejected and more broken.
